



**HOLY FAMILY MAUSOLEUM,
MARKHAM (ON)**

On May 26, 2001, the Catholic Cemeteries Archdiocese of Toronto celebrated the grand opening of their newest Holy Family Mausoleum. C.M.C. completed this turnkey project, on-time with an eighteen-month schedule.

This three-storey building offers many options to its community. These options to the families consist of single and double crypts, family rooms,

oversized crypt spaces, a designated child section and various columbarium areas for a total of over 6000 crypts poured-in-place and 2000 niches. C.M.C. was able to achieve this unique mausoleum by constructing an impressive quantity of prefabricated architectural concrete components at its precast Plant in Kettleby.
