SACRED HEART MAUSOLEUM, ST. CHARLES CEMETERY, FARMINGDALE, LONG ISLAND, NEW YORK

The Roman Catholic Diocese of Brooklyn recently dedicated their new Sacred Heart Mausoleum, located in St. Charles Cemetery on Long Island, New York. The mausoleum contains 1924 casket spaces and 288 niche spaces and follows the "Gothic" design inspiration of the adjacent mausoleum constructed several decades previously.

The new mausoleum design was updated to improve the retail value of the project including the addition of a second indoor chapel. High quality finishes were used throughout including the use of Barre Grey granite for the exterior shutters and arches and polished Crema Marfil marble for the interior shutters.

**CALVARY MAUSOLEUM,
CALVARY CEMETERY,
LOS ANGELES, CA.**

Construction is underway on the 12,584 casket space and 5,368 niche space mausoleum for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles at their Calvary Cemetery in East Los Angeles. An entirely outdoor building, the mausoleum is four-levels high and centers on an interior courtyard that extends through all four levels.

The mausoleum was designed by J. Stuart Todd, Inc. in the Mission Style and incorporates various decorative finishes including the use of cast-stone balustrades and clay roof tiles. Other finishes include the extensive use of both polished and honed red colored Balmoral granite as well as stuccoed wall surfaces. Scheduled completion will be in the Spring of 2003.

**CATHEDRAL OF OUR LADY
OF THE ANGELS, LOS ANGELES, CA.**

Rapidly approaching completion in the summer of 2002 is the new Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels, located in the heart of downtown Los Angeles.

**PIETA MAUSOLEUM,
RESURRECTION CEMETERY,
JEFFERSON CITY, MO.**

Fall 2001 marked the completion of the new Pieta Mausoleum constructed for St. Peter's Cemetery Association at their Resurrection Cemetery in Jefferson City, MO.

This is their third community mausoleum and it contains 778 casket spaces and 182 niche spaces. The central feature in the courtyard will be a life-size bronze Pieta. The dedication for the project is scheduled for Memorial Day 2002.
